

Texshare Card Policy:

In order to be issued a Texshare card, a patron is required to have had a Sanger Public Library card for at least six months. Their account must be in good standing and free of long overdue or lost materials. Cards expire one year from issue date.

For visitors who present a Texshare card to check out materials from the Sanger Public Library:

- Texshare card holders will be required to register for a Sanger Public Library in order to check out materials. A photo ID with current address must be presented to obtain a library card. If the address is no longer valid, a piece of mail such as a utility bill or other official document showing the current address will be needed.
- The first-time checkout limit is two items; upon return of the first checkout/s, the limit for adult cardholders is 15 books and 4 DVDs. For minors, the limit is 10 books and 2 DVDs. The lending period is two weeks for most materials (books/audiobooks/non-fiction DVD) and one week for DVDs. Electronic devices such as Launchpads are excluded.
